



Privacy Statement SchermCentrum Amsterdam

SchermCentrum Amsterdam considers the protection of your personal data important. In our Privacy Statement, we provide clear and transparent information on how we handle personal data.

Privacy

We make every effort to safeguard your privacy and therefore handle personal data with care. SchermCentrum Amsterdam complies with applicable laws and regulations in all cases, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This entails that we:

- Process your personal data in accordance with the purpose for which it was provided; these purposes and types of personal data are described in our Privacy Statement;
- Limit the processing of your personal data to the data that is minimally necessary for the purposes for which it is processed;
- Ask for your explicit consent for the processing of your personal data if necessary;
- Have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the security of your personal data;
- Do not transfer personal data to other parties unless this is necessary for the execution of the purposes for which it was provided;
- Are aware of your rights regarding your personal data, wish to inform you of these rights, and respect them.

SchermCentrum Amsterdam is responsible for the processing of your personal data. If you have questions after reviewing our Privacy Statement or wish to contact us, you can do so via the contact details at the bottom of this document.

Processing of members' personal data

SchermCentrum Amsterdam processes members' personal data for the following purposes:

- Administrative purposes, including the collection of membership fees;
- Communication and/or invitations;
- Informing you about various matters.

The basis for processing this personal data is the registration form.

For the above-mentioned purposes, SchermCentrum Amsterdam requests the following personal data from you:

- First name, surname;
- Date of birth;
- Address (street, house number, postal code, city);
- Nationality;
- Telephone number;
- Email address;
- Gender;
- IBAN;
- Name and address of account holder.

Your personal data is stored by SchermCentrum Amsterdam for the purpose of the aforementioned processing for the period:

- During the duration of the membership and thereafter only in the financial administration for a maximum of 7 years.

Processing of personal data of volunteers

Personal data of volunteers is processed by SchermCentrum Amsterdam for the following purpose:

- Provision of information.

The basis for this personal data is verbal consent.

For the above purpose, SchermCentrum Amsterdam requests the following personal data from you:

- First name, surname;
- Date of birth;
- Address (street, house number, postal code, city);
- Telephone number;
- Email address.

Your personal data is stored by SchermCentrum Amsterdam for the purpose of the aforementioned processing for the period that you are considered a volunteer and for 3 months thereafter.

Provision to third parties

We provide the following data that you give to us to the Royal Dutch General Fencing Association (KNAS) on the basis of the obligations arising from its statutes:

- First name, surname;
- Date of birth;
- Address (street, house number, postal code, city);
- Nationality;

- Gender.

We may provide the data you give us to other third parties if this is necessary for the execution of the purposes described above.

For example, we use a third party for:

- Handling the (financial) administration (ClubCollect).
- Sending newsletters and invitations (MailChimp).

We never pass on personal data to third parties with whom we have not concluded a data processing agreement. With these parties (processors), we naturally make the necessary arrangements to ensure the security of your personal data. Furthermore, we will not provide the data you have provided to other parties unless this is legally required and permitted. We only share personal data with third parties if you give us written permission to do so.

Minors

We only process personal data of minors (persons under the age of 16) if written consent has been given by the parent, guardian, or legal representative.

Retention period

SchermCentrum Amsterdam does not retain personal data for longer than is necessary for the purpose for which it was provided or as required by law.

Security

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against unlawful processing; for example, we have taken the following measures:

- All persons who, on behalf of SchermCentrum Amsterdam, have access to your data those who can take notice of this information are bound by confidentiality regarding it;
- We apply a username and password policy on all our systems;
- We pseudonymize and encrypt personal data when there is a reason to do so;
- We make backups of personal data to be able to restore it in the event of physical or technical incidents;
- We regularly test and evaluate our measures.

Rights regarding your data

You have the right to access, rectify, or delete the personal data that we have received from you. You may object to the processing of your personal data (or part thereof) by us or by one of our processors. You also have the right to have the data provided by you transferred by us to yourself or, at your request, directly to another

party. We may ask you to identify yourself before we can comply with the aforementioned requests.

You always have the right to withdraw consent for the processing of your personal data.

Complaints

If you have a complaint about the processing of your personal data, please contact us directly about this. If we are unable to resolve the matter together with you, you always have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority, which is the supervisory authority in the field of privacy protection.
